

# CADS-NCD Mount Pakenham August 2012 Newsletter

Hard to believe we are talking about skiing in August, but the wheels have been in motion for some time now as we plan for the 2013 season.

## **Program Details**

The 2013 season will consist of **8 weekly lessons, starting January 5** (note the Saturday start this year, to accommodate New Year's Day and March Break holidays). Fees are \$200 for lessons plus a mandatory \$30 membership fee charged by CADS national which covers insurance. Most lessons are one-on-one; some are in small groups. Lessons are approximately one hour in length. Fees include lift tickets and equipment rental, if needed (must indicate on the Application Form).

In addition to the regular instructional program, CADS Mount Pakenham runs a Race Program which operates on Tuesday evenings for 8 weeks. If you would like further information on the Race Program, or would like to find out about eligibility, please contact <u>deannabarry@storm.ca</u>

### **2013 Application Forms**

The 2013 Application Forms are now available to both participant skiers and volunteers.

- RETURNING PARTICIPANT SKIERS: Forms and payment are due by October 1, 2012. If we have not heard from you by this time, we will assign your spot to someone else. If you already know that you won't be returning this season, we would appreciate you advising us, so we can adjust the number of spots available to new families. If you are unsure, or have problems with the fees, please contact us to discuss before October 1.
- NEW PARTICIPANT SKIERS: New participants will be assigned available spots on a first-come first-served basis after October 1 (as forms <u>and</u> payment are received). We recommend you apply early to avoid disappointment.
- VOLUNTEERS: As you know, we depend on you! It's important that we hear from you soon. The \$30 CADS national membership fee is now being paid for by the program for all volunteers, but we still need to get your signed application form for liability purposes, and also for determining teaching assignments. Can you please get these in ASAP so we know how many lessons we can offer in 2013.
